# Two new multimedia radios from Xzent

# With or without sat nav

Universal for all vehicles with 2-DIN radio





With the X-222 and X-422 Xzent has brought out two new monitor car radios with digital radio and Bluetooth that differ in just one though very important point: the navigation.

The Xzent X-422 costs exactly a hundred more than the identically looking X-222. However, at a recommended price of just under 400 euros it still lies in an attractive price segment. For that, besides the complete feature set of the X-222, it also comes with provision for the navigation system including GPS receiver. The matching navigation software X-MAP22FEU is optionally available for just under 100 euros more. This is shipped on a microSD card. After inserting it into

the appropriate slot top right in the front, the Europe-wide 3D navigation covering 47 countries becomes available. Also included is the Premium POI package with around 6.5 million points of interest. Traffic information is taken care of via the TMC, and prominent buildings and landscapes are represented in 3D. An alternative to the X-MAP22FEU car navigation available for just under 200 euros is the camper variant X-MAP22FEU-MH. This allows vehicle parameters such as weight,

length, and height to be considered during route planning, and there is additionally a database available with camping points of interest.

#### **Easy Connect**

Anyone who appreciates a permanently installed navigation system with offline maps should therefore go for the X-422. But you can still navigate with the X-222 – with the aid of a compatible Android smartphone. This is because the X-222 as well as the X-422 has Easy Connect. With a suitable phone connected to the first of two USB ports at the rear you can mirror smartphone apps on the monitor of the car radio and control them via its touch-screen. This works just as well with the music player or Spotify as with Google Maps or other apps.

The second USB port is intended for iOS devices, and supports the Made for iPod/iPhone functionality.

Naturally, media files can also be played directly using USB from mass storage devices like USB sticks.

#### Bluetooth and DAB+

The devices also work together brilliantly with smartphones using a Bluetooth wireless connection to telephone and hear music. If you like listening to radio programs over the air waves both these Xzent models offer two options. The FM tuner receives classic analog FM radio programs, while the digital radio brings a wide choice of stations into the car via DAB+: including comfortable station search, Service Following and MOT Slideshow.

As the microSD slot on the X-222 is not needed for navigation it can be used for media playback. Both devices also offer an HDMI input at the rear – a rarity in this price class.

### Connectivity

Otherwise the rear has a lot of connections to offer. Six separate pre-outs for front, rear, subwoofer and center are also present, as well as the AV input and a video output for additional monitors. Two camera inputs are available so that for example the front and rear cameras can be operated at the same time. A 10-band parametric equalizer is available for adjusting the sound.

#### **Operation**

The X-222 and X-422 are controlled from the large 6.5-in capacitive touchscreen. To control the volume there is a rotary knob, with two sensor buttons above and below for direct access to the main menu, favorites, cameras and navigation. The menus are clearly laid out, the touchscreen reacts

promptly, and as a result overall control is smooth and intuitive.

Also on the test bench the X-222 and X-422 cannot deny their very close relationship: The test readings obtained differ if at all only in the third decimal place, which is clearly within the usual production line tolerance band and in the green zone. The same goes for the practical performance, so that both devices receive the identical assessment from us in the column shown opposite.

As both Xzent models do without a mechanical drive, the casing can be approx. 2 cm shorter than is otherwise usual, which makes installation easier and allows more space for connections a wiring.

# **Summary**

Together with the optional navigation software the Xzent X-422 forms a completely equipped infotainment system at a very attractive price. If you can do without the permanently installed navigation system
